UTILITIES SERVICEPERSON

The City of Tomball is accepting applications for the position of Utilities Serviceperson in the Public Works Department. This position performs maintenance, repairs and construction under direction. This individual will install and repair water, sewer and gas lines, taps meters, etc. There will be some meter reading and public contact. There is strenuous physical work outdoors, some after hour work and considerable hazard to health and body.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience in operating excavation equipment such as backhoe, loaders and other specialized equipment.
- Must be able to obtain Class D water and wastewater licenses within one year from hire.
- Must possess and maintain a valid Class C Texas motor vehicle operator's license.
- Must possess H. S. Diploma or GED.
- Must be able to successfully pass pre-employment drug screening and random drug screening in the DOT covered position pool.

UTILITIES SERVICEPERSON I

- To be hired at this level you must meet the qualifications listed above, possess Class D water and wastewater licenses and have one year of experience working in water, sewer or gas systems

UTILITIES SERVICEPERSON II

- To be hired at this level you must meet the qualifications listed above, possess Class C water and wastewater licenses and have two years of experience working in water, sewer or gas systems
