Pet waste contains bacteria that makes our lakes and rivers unsafe for swimming and other activities.

## What You Can Do

### How Did It Get There?

Stormwater follows the storm drain system and directly outfalls into our streams, rivers and lakes. On its way, stormwater carries with it pollutants such as pet waste.



### Flush It

Pick up pet waste *only*, deposit it into the toilet, and flush it away.



### Bag It and Trash It

Use pet waste bags to pick up after your pet then dispose of them in the trash. Bags are available at public parks or for purchase at stores. You can also reuse shopping bags.



### Bury It

If pet waste is on your property, dig a six-inch-deep hole, put pet waste in the hole, and cover it up with dirt.
