



Free Chipping Service

Monday, April 15 through Friday, April 19

The City will provide free chipping service for brush and small limbs during Spring Cleanup Week. Residents must call (281) 290-1425 by 4 p.m. on Friday, April 12 to schedule.

Make sure to turn all limbs the same direction. Limit size to 6 to 8 feet in length and no more than 6 inches in diameter. Place limbs and brush near the road.

Landfill Drop Offs

8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, April 15 through Friday, April 19

8 a.m. to 2 p.m., Saturday, April 20

The City will provide residents the opportunity to dispose of large, hard-to-handle items that are not collected as part of regular garbage service. Roll offs will be provided at the old City landfill (1200 Rudolph Rd, 0.4 miles North of E. Hufsmith Rd.) **All appliances must be drained and tagged by a licensed technician.**
