


Holiday Service Impact - Solid Waste & Recycling

Louie's Together Playground: A Dream Brought to Life


The City of Tomball and Tomball Legacy Fund are proud to support the creation of Louie's Together Playground, an inclusive playground at Juergens Park inspired by Louie Munson and his incredible family.

Louie, born with a type of dwarfism called Achondroplasia, has a vibrant personality that lights up every room. He loves making people laugh, being the center of attention, and, most of all, anything involving construction!



The story began with a simple photo of Louie dreaming of becoming a construction worker. When doubts were cast on his dream, author Dr. Nichole Julia chose to highlight dwarfism in her book series, The Ables Fables. The resulting story, Louie's Together Playground, features Louie the llama and his friends of all abilities building an inclusive playground where everyone can play.

Inspired by the book, the Munson family worked with the City of Tomball to make Louie's dream a reality. Thanks to the generosity of families, friends, and donors near and far—along with the invaluable support of the Tomball Economic Development Corporation (TEDC) and Chick-fil-A—Louie's Together Playground is now a place where children of all abilities can come together to laugh, play, and build friendships.
