



# CITY OF TOMBALL SPRING CLEANUP WEEK & RECYCLING DAY 2025

To help Tomball residents responsibly dispose of unwanted items and support environmental sustainability, the City of Tomball is hosting its annual Spring Cleanup Week and Recycling Day this April.

**Spring Cleanup Week • Monday, Apr. 21 to Saturday, Apr. 26**

**Free Chipping Service | Monday, Apr. 21 through Friday, Apr. 25**

The City will provide **FREE** chipping service for brush and small limbs during Spring Cleanup Week. Residents must call (281) 290-1425 by **4 p.m. on Thursday, Apr. 17** to schedule.

All limbs must be turned in the same direction. Please limit limb size to 6 to 8 feet in length and no more than 6 inches in diameter. Limbs and brush must be placed near the road by **7:00 a.m. on Monday, Apr. 21**.

**Landfill Drop-Offs | Monday, Apr. 21 through Friday, Apr. 25 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.  
Saturday, Apr. 26 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

The City will provide residents the opportunity to dispose of large, hard-to-handle items that are not collected as part of regular garbage service. **Roll-offs will be provided at the old City landfill (1200 Rudolph Rd, 0.4 miles north of E. Hufsmith Rd.)** All appliances must be drained and tagged by a licensed technician.
