

#### Attention Commercial Garbage Customers

To ensure consistent and safe waste collection services, the City has implemented an overage fee for commercial dumpsters that are overfilled and cannot be fully closed.

**Each overage pickup will result in an additional charge of \$135.13 being assessed.\***

To avoid this fee, please ensure that all waste is contained within the dumpster, and the lid is fully closed at the time of collection.

#### Proper Disposal of Hazardous Household Waste

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) provides guidance for residents on safely managing and disposing of household hazardous waste (HHW), which includes common items like corrosive cleaners, paints, fuels, pesticides, and fluorescent bulbs that can pose safety and environmental risks if not handled properly.

While some HHW may be legally placed in regular trash, Harris County offers a designated drop-off location and reoccurring HazMobile events for Harris County residents where these materials can be disposed of in a more protective manner. We encourage residents to store products in their original containers, never mix chemicals, and take advantage of local HHW disposal options to keep hazardous materials out of landfills, storm drains, and the environment.

## SPRING CLEANUP WEEK & RECYCLING DAY 2026

To help Tomball residents responsibly dispose of unwanted items and support environmental sustainability, the City of Tomball is hosting its annual Spring Cleanup Week and Recycling Day this April.

### Spring Cleanup Week • Monday, Apr. 20 to Saturday, Apr. 25

Free Chipping Service | Service will be during the week of Apr. 20

The City will provide **FREE** chipping service for brush and small limbs during Spring Cleanup Week. Residents must call **(281) 290-1425** from **Monday, Apr. 13 to Friday, Apr. 17 by 3:00 p.m.** to schedule. All limbs must be turned in the same direction. Please limit limb size to 6 to 8 feet in length and no more than 6 inches in diameter. Limbs and brush must be placed near the road by **6:00 a.m. on Monday, Apr. 20.**

**Landfill Drop-Offs** | 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday, Apr. 20 through Thursday, Apr. 23  
8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Friday, Apr. 24 and 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Saturday, Apr. 26

The City will provide residents the opportunity to dispose of large, hard-to-handle items that are not collected as part of regular garbage service. **A current utility bill must be presented at time of service.** Roll-offs will be provided at the old City landfill (1200 Rudolph Rd, 0.4 miles north of E. Hufsmith Rd.) All appliances must be drained and tagged by a licensed technician.
